Recently voted as the top Australian Shiraz, Angels Share is made by the incredibly successful Two Hands winery. Brilliantly opulent fruit with juicy brambles and blackcurrant notes followed by rich creamy palate and long succulent finish. A real stunner!

Utilising fruit from the cooler Eden Valley, Thorn Clarke are able to make a wine with crisp, well balanced tropical fruit and subtle oak ageing. Well rounded, with touches of pineapple and toasty vanilla, this is classy stuff.
- 64. SEMILLON SAUVIGNON, STELLA BELLA, MARGARET RIVER** **£27.90**  
A classic Margaret River blend of crisp, grassy Sauvignon and tangy, citrusy Semillon. Vibrant, massively refreshing and likely to become a true star.

The result of careful selection of the best grapes followed by ageing in oak barrels, this Merlot is a rich, ripe, fleshy example of its type. Packed full of succulent blackcurrant with hints of mint and chocolate, it is a supple, satisfying red.
- 68. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CARMENÈRE, DUETTE, MAIPO** **£19.90**  
Sourced from vines grown in the Alta Maipo region, close to Santiago, Duette is a blend of the classic Cabernet Sauvignon and the increasingly well known Carmenere grape. The combination produces a well structured wine with delicious succulent black fruits, touches of eucalyptus and menthol and a long savoury finish.

Produced from fruit grown in the cool Casablanca Valley, this is crisp, well defined and full of juicy grapefruit and gooseberry character.

A rich velvety expression of South Africa's native grape. Soft, jammy, slightly smoky fruit mingles with savoury spiciness and gentle oaking.

Produced from some of the finest vineyard sites on the Paardeburg Mountain in South Africa's Swartland region, this blend of Syrah and Carignan has intense, concentrated creamy dark berry fruits overlaid with hints of mocha, dried cherries and wood spice.

Packed with succulent flavours of apple, pineapple and citrus with hints of ginger, honeysuckle and orange blossom and a lovely minerality. Bright and tasty it is made without any oak to preserve the grape's "original" vibrant fresh fruit character.
- 75. SAUVIGNON BLANC, LANDS END, CAPE AGULHAS** £24.90  
Situated at the most southerly point of Africa, Land's End Estate produces iconic Sauvignon Blanc and Syrah from an extreme microclimate. In vineyards where the pruners sometimes have trouble standing up because of the wind, the grapes ripen slowly giving great intensity of flavour and texture. Low yields and careful winemaking further add complexity to make what will become one of the textbook Sauvignons from the Cape. Concentrated gooseberry, mineral and guava character with a mouth watering, crisp, tangy finish.

A vibrant, enticing pink packed with wild strawberry fruit and hints of cassis. Crisp, mouth wateringly moreish and finishing with a flourish.

## *Argentina Red*

- 77. MALBEC, SANTA ROSA, MENDOZA** £19.50  
Quickly becoming the most important red for Argentina, this Bordeaux export produces full, robust wines with deep plummy fruit, structured tannins and good length.
- 78. "Q" TEMPRANILLO, FAMILIA ZUCCARDI, MENDOZA** £32.90  
The top wine from our Familia Zuccardi range and a clear warning to other countries that Argentina is serious about making quality wine. Huge concentration of ripe strawberry and plum laden fruit. Clever use of oak and a long, long finish.

Santa Rosa were one of the first wineries in Argentina to produce Viognier and it has been a massive hit. Well balanced, with crisp acidity and measured alcohol. Apricot fruit dominates with just a touch of spice.
- 80. TORRONTES, VIDA ORGANICA, ZUCCARDI, MENDOZA** £18.90  
Torrontes is a uniquely aromatic, exotic variety and this organic version is no exception. Lovely texture and weight with the character of citrus, lychee and spice coming through on the palate.
